

Brush and Debris Information

The City will pick up small amounts of trash and debris for residents. Larger amounts of trash and debris may require a payload charge. If payload fees are required the following charges can be applied to your utility bill or you can pay at City Hall.

Brush Payload Fee:	\$30 per truck load
Debris Payload Fee:	\$30 per load plus \$25 per ton
Remodeling Debris (if remodeling is by property owner)	\$30 per ton

Contractors are required for disposal of trash and debris for any contracted work.

*These are amounts that the city is charged by the landfill.

Brush and Debris must be separated

Limbs cannot be mixed with furniture and household items, because they are taken to different landfills.

Items that we are unable to pick up

Tires

Batteries

Hazardous materials such as paint and motor oil

*Please make sure that there are no power lines, cables, fences, poles, etc., that would prohibit us from getting to the brush and/or debris.
